



Guidelines for International Student Financial Support

Approved in Administration Meeting (2016/10/26)

I. Purpose: To encourage excellent international students to receive higher education and develop outstanding professionals and expertise and complete studies at Central Taiwan University of Science and Technology (CTUST).

II. Recipient Status:

1. An individual of foreign nationality, who has never held a nationality status from the Republic of China and who does not possess an overseas Chinese student status at the time of his/her application, is qualified to apply for admission under this regulation.
2. The limited positions can only provide 20 positions for this scholarship; the total amount for new students (excluding re-entrants) per academic year is NT\$ 1 million. The number of recipients and the amount of scholarship are depended upon the CTUST's fund accordingly.

III. Content of Financial Support

1. The amount of scholarship is NT\$50,000 for each award recipient in the first academic year. The first period of the scholarships issue are at the end of May and the second period of the scholarships issue are at the end of November each year.
2. The list of award recipients will be reviewed by the host department and college, and the budget will be submitted by the Center of Student Recruitment & International Cooperation to school's Accounting Office.

IV. Duration of financial support:

The scholarship is tenable for an initial 1 year. Those who are not enrolled in the course of the year or those who have dropped the scholarship will not be eligible for retention or extension.

V. Eligibility: Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Take part in at least 80% of the activities held by Center of Student Recruitment & International Cooperation (Academic Affairs Office) and other school supports.
2. When the student has met the requirements of school admission, the system will be automatically reviewed of your scholarship qualification without additional application.

VI. Termination:

1. If scholarship award recipients are confirmed any violation or falsify, the scholarship will be terminated immediately, and the amount received in violation of the above code will be reclaimed.
2. If scholarship award recipients have to drop out, or are expelled from CTUST, the award will be terminated. If the term has not yet been issued, the payment shall be stopped immediately.
3. Applicants of this financial support may NOT apply from any other financial supports of Taiwan government scholarships for international students at the same time.

VII. Related issues not specified in the Guidelines are subject to the governance of other related regulations or laws of the University.
